Amendments to Bylaws:

7-2 National Representatives/ Delegates

7-2-A National Committee:

At the regular annual convention held in March, the Green Party shall elect representatives to the National Committee. In addition to their duties on the national committee, these representatives shall serve on the state steering committee. The convention shall elect the number of representatives prescribed by the national committee.

The representatives to the national committee shall actively participate in all votes taken by that body. They shall keep the NM Green Council and Steering Committee informed about important or potentially controversial decisions and activities of the national party, and shall vote in accordance with decisions made by the Green Council or, if the council has not acted, in accord with the state platform.

7-2-B Presidential Nominating Convention:

In years in which the national party holds a Presidential Nominating Convention, at the regular annual convention held in March or at a state nominating convention held in accordance with the bylaws, the Green Party shall elect the number of delegates to the Presidential Nominating Convention prescribed by the national committee. The delegation should select a chair from among its membership.

In addition, in years in which the Party is not considered a Major Party, the convention shall conduct an election for candidates for the President of the United States. All candidates who have declared their candidacy for the office of President shall be included on the ballot. None of the Above shall also appear on the ballot. The delegation to the Presidential nominating convention shall cast votes in proportion to the results of the election. After the first ballots cast at the nominating convention, each delegate may vote according to his or her wishes after an attempt to reach a consensus decision with the entire delegation.
